



Removing the Protective Film from Stainless Steel Products

Many Brayco stainless steel products, including benches, cabinets, and workstations, are supplied with a protective film to help prevent scratches during transport and installation.

How to Remove the Protective Film

For the best results:

1. Start at a corner or edge and gently lift the film using your fingernail or a plastic scraper.
2. Apply gentle heat using a household hairdryer. Hold the hairdryer approximately 10–15 cm away from the surface and warm a small section of the film at a time.
3. Slowly peel the film back while continuing to apply gentle heat. This helps soften the adhesive and makes removal easier.
4. Continue working in small sections until all film has been removed.

If Adhesive Residue Remains:

Occasionally, some adhesive residue may remain on the stainless steel surface. This can usually be removed with:

- Warm soapy water and a soft cloth
- A stainless steel cleaner
- Citrus-based adhesive removers suitable for stainless steel

Always test cleaning products on a small, inconspicuous area first.

Important:

- Do not use sharp metal tools, knives, or blades, as these may scratch the stainless steel surface.
- Do not overheat the surface. Gentle, even heat is all that is required.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners, steel wool, or scouring pads.
